FairHoPe Hospice and Palliative Care, Inc. in partnership with The Robert K. Fox Family Y and United Way are committed to provide no cost grief support to families and children who have experienced the death of a special person. A three-hour program will be offered bi-monthly on Saturdays at the Family Y. Grieving children and adolescents will explore art, music, and physical activity to express themselves while learning to build relationships. The program will be limited to 12 participants. FairHoPe's Children's Grief Specialist, Music Therapist, Social Worker, and Volunteers will facilitate the program with additional support from selected Robert K. Fox Family Y staff.

The Family Y is donating space for Family Zumba, craft time, oral sharing, musical expression, and team building. Adult(s) accompanying the child will be given an opportunity to participate in the Zumba as well as receiving information regarding the Family Y programming, facilities, and scholarships. A one week free pass to use the Y will be made available to each family.

We believe that children, adolescents, and families need supported as they learn to cope with a death while also learning to honor the memory of their person. FairHoPe Hospice and Palliative Care, Inc. in partnership with The Robert K. Fox Family Y and United Way believe that families need opportunities and activities that help remind them that they are still family.
